

Turtle

Materials needed :

- an egg box
- a green piece of carton in a circular shape, (about 20 centimeters, 8 inch diameter)
- green and brown paint
- paintbrushes
- white and black paper
- glue
- scissors

Let's get to work:

1. Cut the egg box in pieces, for every leg you'll need two shells from the egg box. The head will be made out of three shells from the egg box.
2. Let the children paint everything green first, then they'll add the brown spots.
3. After everything has dried, we can put the turtle together. Use strong glue otherwise the turtle won't hold together. Start by turning the turtle's shell upside down and glue the legs on the inside of the turtle's shell. Do the same with the head but make sure the head sticks out more than the legs.
4. Finish the project by making eyes and a tail.
